# Facial Aesthetics Courses Preparatory Courses

#### CE-Approved Introduction to Aesthetics (INTRO 101)

An overview and introduction to the art and science of facial aesthetics. Topics covered include facial anatomy, the aging process, and the concept of Facial BeautiФication, with the Greek symbol Phi indicating the Golden Ratio.

## Facial Mannequin Training Program (MANN 201)\*

Overcoming any anxiety you feel about injecting can sometimes seem challenging. But when you have a chance to first practice and perfect your injection skills on a facial mannequin, you'll soon feel comfortable and confident about treating actual patients. This is a comprehensive Botox & Dermal Fillers training course that provides an overview and demonstration of Botox and Dermal Fillers.

Course Mode: Virtual, Self-Paced Cost: \$1,995 (non-members)

#### Non-Surgical Rhinoplasty Training (RNO 201)

The goal of this online program is to teach practitioners how to safely and accurately perform non-surgical rhinoplasty using dermal fillers and neurotoxins. Attendees learn the concept of non-surgical rhinoplasty, nose anatomy, danger and safe injection zones, aesthetic analysis of the nose, proper patients selection, treatment plan, dermal fillers injectable techniques, indications, contraindications, complications and how to manage these complications.

Course Mode: Virtual, Self-Paced

## Vector Facelift by Dermal Fillers (VF 301)

The goal of this online program is to teach students the CosmoFacelift procedure, a one-hour, natural, non-surgical facelift performed using the dermal filler RADIESSE. Additional topics covered include facial anatomy, the aging process, and the concept of Facial BeautiΦication, with the Greek symbol Phi indicating the Golden Ratio. Students are introduced to these various concepts and learn how to conduct facial vector analysis on patients. Finally, students view a demo of the CosmoFacelift performed on a live patient by faculty.

#### Jawline and Chin Enhancement (JAW 301)

A proportional chin and a well-defined jawline are key components of an attractive face. The chin, jawline, and gonial angle define the lower face by visually separating the face from the neck and are responsible for shaping the lower face. These anatomical areas help frame the face and can determine how masculine or feminine your face looks. Upon completion of this course, students will understand the difference between masculine and feminine lower face measurements and how to achieve optimal results for masculine, younger feminine, & mature feminine profiles.

Course Mode: Virtual, Self-Paced

### Forehead Contouring With Dermal Fillers (FC 301)

As we get older, the face starts to deflate due to volume loss of fat and bone. This causes the forehead to become flatter or even concave. In order to reverse this aesthetic disharmony, we can inject dermal fillers to enhance the projection and contour of the forehead to re-establish harmony. Combining dermal fillers with Botox can help smoothen the expressive lines and rejuvenate the skin texture. The goal of this online program is to teach students how to use injectables to achieve the optimal masculine and feminine forehead contour.

## Basic Liposuction Training (LIPO 201)

LIPO 201 is a comprehensive online body aesthetics training program designed to provide members with a robust foundation for understanding tumescent liposuction and liposculpting. Dr. Assassa provides his knowledge and professional expertise with training video content that covers essential tumescent and liposculpting topics. This online liposuction training course serves as a preparation program for the hands-on training course, LIPO 301, and is designed to provide an understanding of tumescent liposuction and liposculpting on both a fundamental and introductory level.

#### **Hands-On Certification Course**

#### Advanced Liposuction Training (LIPO 301)

Liposuction 301 is a three-day, small group liposuction training course on liposuction & liposculpting techniques conducted by experienced physician instructors. # **Program Requirements & Eligibility**

The majority of courses require participants to have a certain level of education. Those with the title of MD, DO, PA, NP, BSN, or RN are eligible for all AAAMS courses. Other practitioners are admitted on a course-by-course basis.

DDS, DMD, and BDS are eligible for all Facial Aesthetics courses. This encompasses any AAAMS course except:

- Beginner Liposuction Training (LIPO 201)
- Advanced Liposuction Training (LIPO 301)

LPN & LVNs are eligible for the following course:

Introduction to the Business of Aesthetics (BUS 101)

Dental hygienists can perform Botox and dermal fillers in certain states. Dental hygienists are eligible for all courses except:

- Beginner Liposuction Training (LIPO 201)
- Advanced Liposuction Training (LIPO 301)

If your state does not allow dental hygienists to perform Botox or dermal fillers, dental hygienists are eligible to take the following course:
